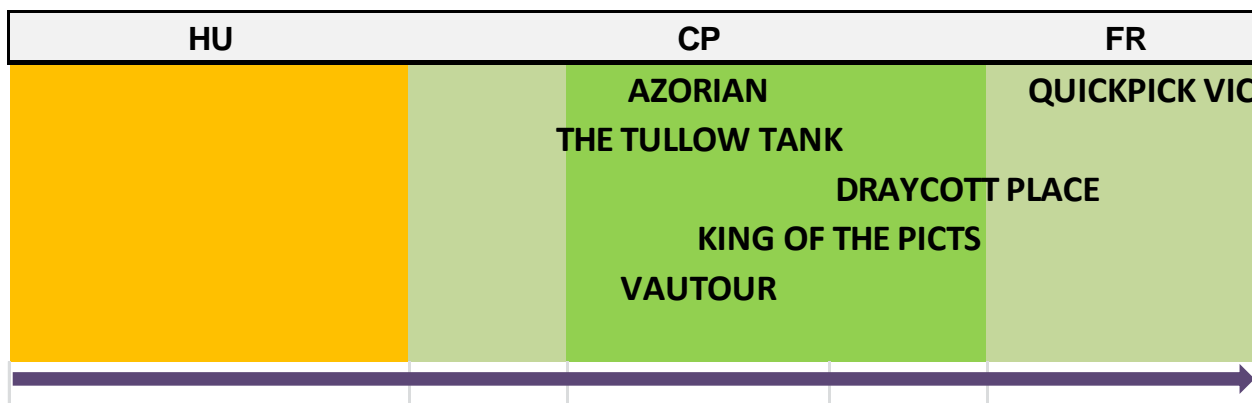

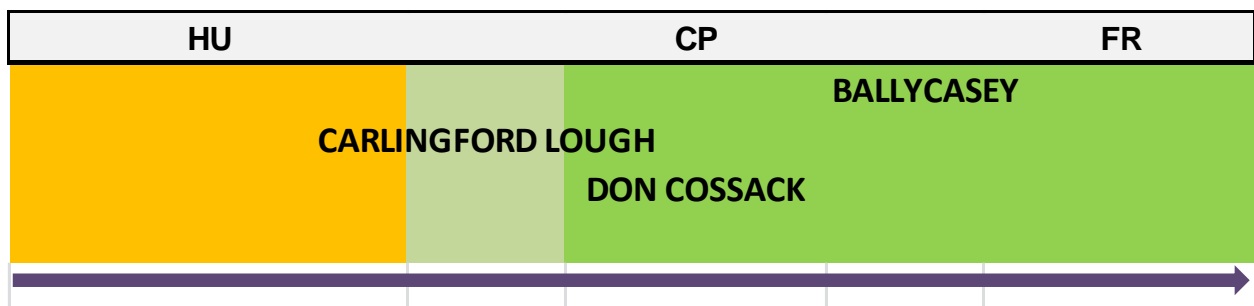

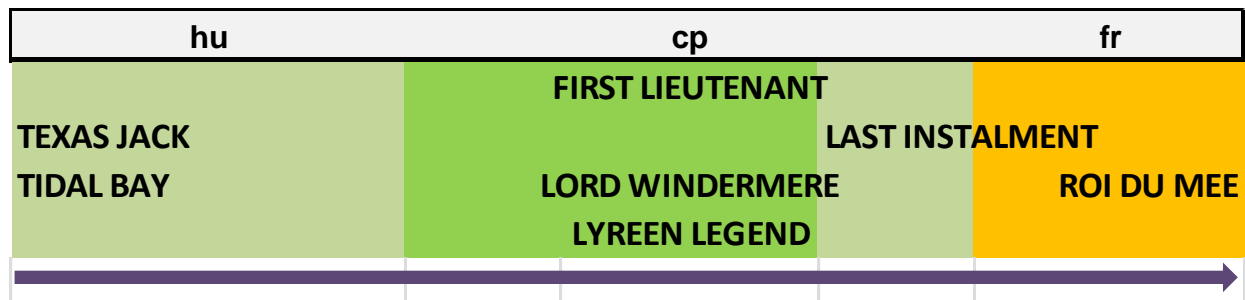

**FIRST LIEUTENANT (M Morris)** – On his best form he surely wins this. Leopardstown is a track he always runs his race at (1222) and Bryan Cooper back in the saddle is a big plus (232213). He only found a back to form Bobs Worth too good for him last time out and he is the one to beat here.

### Alternative(s)

**LAST INSTALMENT (P Fenton)** – I don't usually back 2 in a race with only 7 runners in it but Tidal Bay looks too short to me and gives me value to play both the Gigginstown House runners. I was mightily impressed by his comeback run last month and he will surely have come on a massive amount for this, which looks to be his main target. He is 2 from 2 at the track, has solid form of 13111 on Soft & Heavy ground, jockey Brian O'Connell is 3 from 3 on him, he is a dual Grade 1 winner and is unbeaten February (2 from 2). I want him on side here as back to his best he is very closely matched with First Lieutenant.
