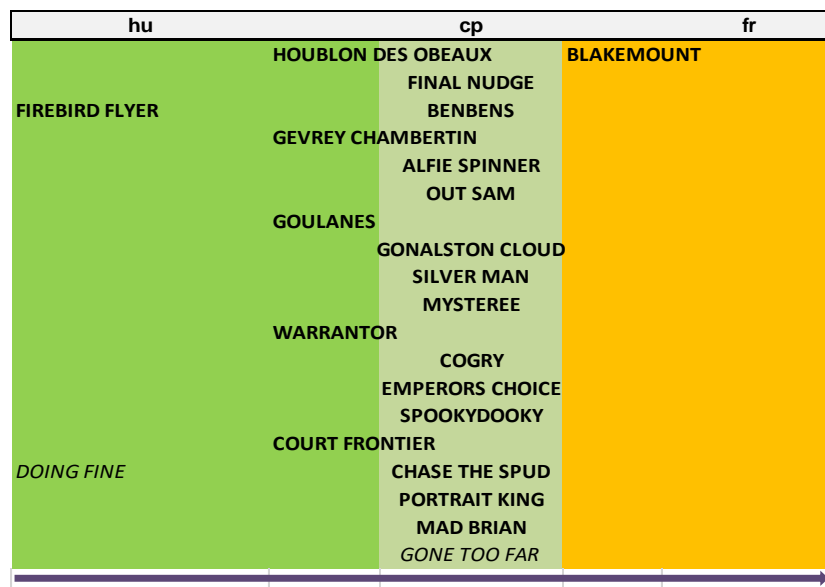

SPOOKYDOOKY (JJ O'Neill) – These conditions look ideal for the 9yo (LH – DSLR 45 or less – flat/slightly undulating track = form of 113124P, all 3 career wins). He ran a fine 4th in this last year and gets in this time round from a 13lb lower mark and he comes in here off the back of a fine 3rd at Exeter in the Devon National. There's plenty here pointing towards a big run from him.

CHASE THE SPUD (F O'Brien) – Not always the most consistent horse but there are bits and pieces of his form that put him in the picture here and with no confirmed front-runner in the line-up there is a chance he could sneak the early lead if they want to. He's weighted to turn the form around with Mysteree on their Haydock meeting from November and is interesting at bigger prices.

MYSTEREE (M Scudamore) – It's worth having the Eider winner on side here as well as Scudamore looks to have gotten plenty of improvement out of him and he clearly relishes these marathon trips (1P41 over 3m4.5f+). There is rain forecast so that will put things more in his favour and Robbie Dunne keeping the ride is a definite bonus.
